Student Grade Appeal Form

INSTRUCTIONS: A grade inquiry may be initiated when the student believes the final grade assigned for a course is inaccurate. The student may petition on the grounds that the instructor did not follow published grading policies, that the grade was not correctly calculated, or that the process of grading was not applied consistently in the class. For grading matters pertaining to Honor Code violations, students must follow Honor Code procedures. Grades on assignments within a course may not be appealed. If discussion with the relevant instructor does not resolve the grade appeal, complete this form in careful detail and submit to the department chair in which the course was taught. If the department chair and instructor agree to a change of grade, the instructor will submit a Change of Grade form to the Registrar. If the petition
