## WHERE & HOW TO REPORT HAZING:

Because hazing activity is intended to can be difficult to investigate. Reports of hazing can be made anonymously; however, it is very important to be specific about <a href="who">who</a> is involved, <a href="who">what</a> was observed, <a href="who">when</a> and <a href="who">where</a> the incident occurred relevant and specific information.
